The 1980, 1990 and 2000 census data on the Hispanic population are not directly comparable to the 1970 data because of overall improvements in the latter censuses, better coverage of the population, improved question design, and an effective public relations program. Also there are no data on the number of White Non-Hispanics and Black Non-Hispanics. The Hispanic population should not be counted as part of the total to avoid double counting, but can be a percentage of the total.
