This day came the defendant, **JOHNATHAN N SCRUGGS**, who stands indicted for two felonies and one misdemeanor, to-wit: Malicious Wounding and Impeding a Police Officer and Brandishing a Machete, was led to the bar in the custody of the Sheriff and came also **Joseph King** his attorney.

Whereupon, the Attorney for the Commonwealth moved the Court to amend Count One of the indictment to Unlawful Wounding, and there being no objection thereto by the defendant, said motion was granted and the Court ordered that the indictment be amended accordingly.

Whereupon, the accused was arraigned and after private consultation with his said counsel, pleaded GUILTY to Unlawful Wounding as charged in amended Count 1 and GUILTY to Impeding a Police Officer as charged in Count 2 and GUILTY to Brandishing a Machete as charged in Count 3, which plea was tendered by the accused in person, and the Court, having made inquiry and being of the opinion that the accused fully understood the nature and effect of his plea and of the penalties that may be imposed upon his conviction and of the waiver of trial by jury and of appeal, and finding that his plea was voluntarily and intelligently made, proceeded to hear and determine the case without the intervention of a jury as provided by law.

Having heard the evidence and the argument of counsel, the Court finds the defendant guilty of the following offenses:

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT 1

On or about the 3rd day of April, 2007, in the City of Alexandria, Virginia, JOHNATHAN NEIL SCRUGGS did unlawfully, feloniously and maliciously cause bodily injury to Ashley Jamison by means of striking and beating with hands and feet and with the intent to maim, disfigure, disable and kill.


